

Crack me up!

This thief was a contract cleaner—not an employee. She can be seen on numerous other videos looking throughout the store for money.

In the video you can see her enter the back room of the store and smoke crack on two occasions as well as count out money that she is about to steal. This money was secreted away for emergency expenses, but not well enough for her not to find. She also charged the company for services that she did not perform. She was clueless to the fact that her behavior was captured on covert video.

Notice in her confession where she talks about "smoking crack that night" and "counting out \$200 in the back room." She said she could not recall which store it was since she was smoking crack that night. This is on the video clip!

Over a 2wk. period I stole around \$2200.00 from the [REDACTED] stores. I needed a way to pay my bills as room~~mate~~ had ~~to~~ moved leaving me with extra bills. I also used the money for other things - such as shopping, Gas, cigarettes, food, & Drugs. I had accidentally ran across the money ~~to~~ while cleaning the floors, in cabinets, under trash bags in garbage cans, or under the chairs. There was one night I remember counting out \$200 in the back room of one of the stores I am not sure which store as I was also smoking crack that night. I have friends & family supporting me & helping me to get ~~through~~ this. I have at times taken toilet paper, shampoo & other items. Over the last couple of years I'd say it adds up to about \$300.00 worth of miscellaneous stuff.

There was, also, 20 locations, in the last 2 mos. that did not get cleaned. that I was paid for.

Based on the amount I get paid I was ~~paid~~ paid \$941 dollars more than I was supposed to get

I realize that I've cost [redacted] \$3,441.00 + 1559.00 for a total of \$5,000.00 or ¹⁵⁵⁹ more based on what [redacted] had to pay \$5,000.00

for the work & the moneys I took. I know what I did was wrong & I have friends & family supporting me & helping me to get through this and ensure it will not happen again. It is my belief that if I had not been on drugs this would not have happened. I realize that what I did is against the law & that I could be prosecuted for it. I am not an employee of [redacted] but I felt that it was important and in my best interest to talk to Mr. Urban about what I had been taking from the stores. He made no promises & did, in no way, coerce me. I took it upon myself to be as honest as I could & discuss these things with him. I was told I would receive a copy of this statement.
